Practice Schedule: MWF 3:30-5:30. This may vary somewhat based on field issues and coaching availability. Players will be notified of changes by email, and it will be noted on the website.

Spring Tournament Schedule:

Competition is mainly comprised of tournaments. Any tournament your child attends will have an associated cost to cover the tournament bid, transportation and possibly housing costs.

Mixed tournament = Coed

Open & Girls tournament = Boy's team and Girl's team

- **OHSUR AND OHSUC** – State tournaments. One is Mixed and one is Open and Mixed. Location and dates are undetermined. Expect these will be local.

Fees and Forms: The Spring fee is \$100. This fee will include jerseys, shorts, insurance, and other season costs. Checks should be made out to "Churchill High School" and taken to the financial office at school. Please write the student's name and Ultimate in the comment line. There are two forms: Medical Release/Student information form, and Boy Scout insurance form.

- **Fees and forms need to be turned in by Friday, March 6.** After that date, students will not be allowed to participate in practices or tournaments until fees are received.
- Medical Release/Student info form: once for the whole season.
- Boy Scout Venturing form: only for new students (see below).
- Any tournament fees will be separate.
- Requests for financial assistance can be directed to Kris Bofto.

UPA Membership: \$20 cost to be paid directly to the UPA. Membership is required for any player planning to participate in Westerns or the State tournament. The Ultimate Players Association (UPA) is the governing body for the sport of Ultimate in the U.S. It is a not-for-profit organization whose mission is to promote the sport of Ultimate, and provide a framework for the organization of Ultimate activities.
